

**Teaching resource 10**  
**Dictionary Origami (lesson 2 session 6)**

**Blow:** to push out air from your mouth

**Diagonal:** a line that connects opposite corners of a flat shape.

**Expand:** to increase in size. To make something become larger.

**Flap:** a thin flat piece of something that is fixed to something else along one edge. An envelop has a flap at the back.

**Flat:** level and parallel to the ground: Smooth on the surface.

**Fold:** to bend a piece of paper or cloth and press one part of it over another part.

**Origami:** the Japanese art of folding pieces of paper to make a model

**Pocket:** a small bag that forms part of a piece of clothing and is used for holding small objects.

**Press:** to push something to make it flat.

**Tuck:** to push a piece of material somewhere to make it tidy.

**Unfold:** to open something that was folded.
