DISCOVERING 3D SHAPES

Teaching resource 10 Dictionary Origami (lesson 2 session 6)

Blow: to push out air from your mouth

Diagonal: a line that connects opposite corners of a flat shape.

Expand: to increase in size. To make something become larger.

Flap: a thin flat piece of something that is fixed to something else along one edge. An envelop has a flap at the back.

Flat: level and parallel to the ground: Smooth on the surface.

Fold: to bend a piece of paper or cloth and press one part of it over another part.

Origami: the Japanese art of folding pieces of paper to make a model

Pocket: a small bag that forms part of a piece of clothing and is used for holding small objects.

Press: to push something to make it flat.

Tuck: to push a piece of material somewhere to make it tidy.

Unfold: to open something that was folded.
