

LESSON 3: SCULPTURE - MAIN FEATURES. Activity 3 (laminated cards)



- The name of this sculpture is **Man with a Guitar**.
- The sculptor who made it is **JACQUES LIPCHITZ** (American).
- He made it in 1915.
- It is currently displayed in the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA), New York.
- **DESCRIPTION:**
 - It has got an abstract shape.
 - It is brownish.
 - It is 97.2 x 26.6 x 19.5 cm.
 - It is made out of limestone.

- The name of this sculpture is **Man Pointing**.
- The sculptor who made it is **ALBERTO GIACOMETTI** (Swiss).
- He made it in 1947.
- It is currently displayed in the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA), New York.
- DESCRIPTION:
 - It has got a human shape.
 - It is bronze.
 - It is 179 x 103.4 x 41.5 cm.
 - It is made out of bronze.

- The name of this sculpture is **The Bride**.
- The sculptor who made it is HENRY MOORE (British).
- He made it in 1939-40.
- It is currently displayed in the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA), New York.
- DESCRIPTION:
 - It has got an abstract shape.
 - It is black and copper.
 - It is 23.8 x 10.3 x 10 cm.
 - It is made out of cast lead and copper wire.

- The name of this sculpture is **Maquette for Guitar**.
- The sculptor who made it is **PABLO PICASSO** (Spanish).
- He made it in 1912.
- It is currently displayed in the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA), New York.
- DESCRIPTION:
 - It has got a guitar shape.
 - It is brown.
 - It is 65.1 x 33 x 19 cm.
 - It is made out of cardboard, string and restored wire.

- The name of this sculpture is **La Serpentine**.
- The sculptor who made it is **HENRI MATISSE** (French).
- He made it in 1909.
- It is currently displayed in the **Matisse Museum of Nice, France**.
- **DESCRIPTION:**
 - It has got a human shape.
 - It is bronze.
 - It is 56.5 x 28.5 x 19 cm.
 - It is made out of bronze.

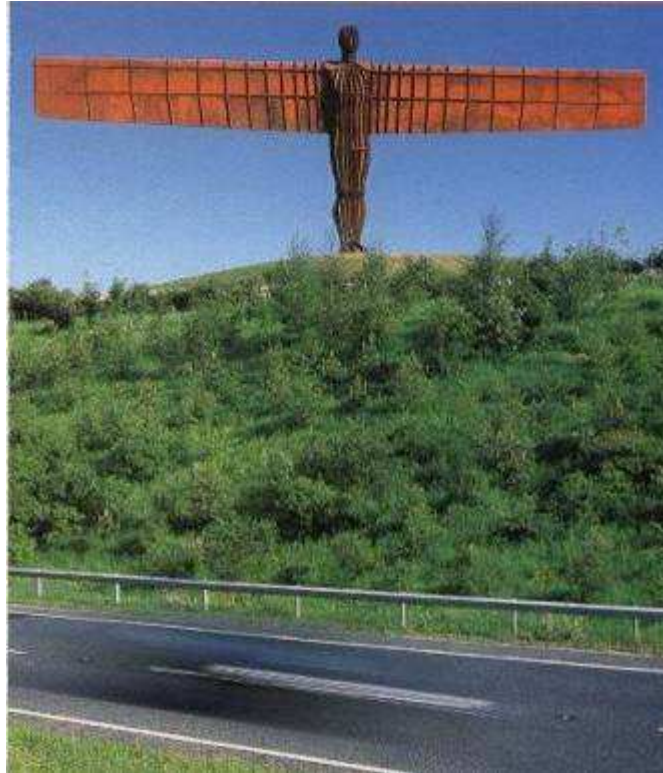
- The name of this sculpture is **Bust of the Young Balzac**.
- The sculptor who made it is **AUGUSTE RODIN** (French).
- He made it in 1891.
- It is currently displayed in the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA), New York.
- **DESCRIPTION:**
 - It has got a bust shape.
 - It is bronze.
 - It is 43.8 x 38.7 x 23.6 cm.
 - It is made out of bronze.

- The name of this sculpture is Persistence of Memory.
- The sculptor who made it is SALVADOR DALI (Spanish).
- He made it in 1980.
- It is currently displayed in ...
- DESCRIPTION:
 - It is a branch with a clock hanging.
 - It is bronze with a blue patina.
 - It is 37cm. high, including the base.
 - It is made out of bronze.

LESSON 3: SCULPTURE - MAIN FEATURES. Activity 3 (laminated cards)



- The name of this sculpture is **Angel of the North**.
- The sculptor who made it is **ANTONY GORMLEY**.
- He made it in 1995.
- It is located in Northern England, greeting visitors as they enter Gateshead by road and by rail.
- DESCRIPTION:
 - It has got a human shape with wings instead of arms.
 - It is red.
 - It is 20m high, 54m wide.
 - It is made out of 700 tones of concrete, 32 tones of steel (and 52 bolts to hold the angel in place).



- The name of this sculpture is **Head-Skull**.
- The sculptor who made it is **ALBERTO GIACOMETTI** (Swiss).
- He made it in 1933-34.
- It is currently displayed in the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA), New York.
- DESCRIPTION:
 - It has got an abstract head-skull shape.
 - It is white.
 - It is 18.5 x 20 x 22.5 cm.
 - It is made out of plaster.

- The name of this sculpture is **Whale II**.
- The sculptor who made it is **ALEXANDER CALDER** (American).
- He made it in 1964 (replica of 1937 original)
- It is located in New York (sculpture garden at *MoMA*).
- **DESCRIPTION:**
 - It has got a whale shape.
 - It is black.
 - It is 172.8 x 176.5 x 115 cm.
 - It is made out of painted sheet steel, supported by a log of wood.

- The name of this sculpture is **Elmwood Reclining Figure**.
- The sculptor who made it is **HENRY MOORE** (British).
- He made it in 1936.
- It is currently displayed in **Hepworth Wakefield Art Gallery, UK**.
- **DESCRIPTION:**
 - It has got a human-like shape.
 - It is brown.
 - It is ____ x ____ x ____ cm.
 - It is made out of elmwood.



- The name of this sculpture is **The Three Shades**.
- The sculptor who made it is **AUGUSTE RODIN** (French).
- He made it in 1881-86.
- It is currently displayed in the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA), New York.
- **DESCRIPTION:**
 - It has got a human shape.
 - It is bronze.
 - It is 97.3 x 92.2 x 49.5 cm.
 - It is made out of bronze.
